MOST HOLY TRINITY PARISH BANNER REQUEST **BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to approve the request from Most Holy Trinity Parish to place banners on Second Street announcing the July parish festival. Motion carried.

VILLAGE OF FOWLER CODE OF ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 93 **BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to adopt the following amendment to Chapter 93 of the Village of Fowler Code of Ordinances:

THE VILLAGE OF FOWLER ORDINANCES:

Chapter 93. Streets and Sidewalks, Section 93.02, Construction and Maintenance of Sidewalks, subsection (B) is amended as follows:

Sec 93.02 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF SIDEWALKS.

(B) *Specifications and permits.* No person shall construct, rebuild or repair any sidewalk within the village limits except in accordance with specifications established for such sidewalks and must first obtain a written permit and specifications from the Village Superintendent. Only a licensed contractor approved by the Village Superintendent may perform such work. However, Fowler Village Department of Public Works employees retain the right to make sidewalk installations and/or repairs as deemed necessary by said department.

Motion carried.

TRAIL DONATION **BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to pledge \$10,000.00 to the proposed Owosso to Ionia Rails-to-Trails project with a strong recommendation to pave the trail from Bauer Rd. to Tallman Rd. Motion carried.

TAX BILL ADDITIONS **BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Smith moved, supported by Trustee Klein, to add \$981.83 in unpaid sidewalk receipts and \$321.79 in unpaid water/sewer/trash bills to 2011 Village of Fowler tax bills. Motion carried.

MERS BENEFIT E PROGRAM **BOARD ACTION:** Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to opt out of participation in MERS Benefit E Program. Motion carried.

CONTRADICTION OF LIVESTOCK KEEPING IN VILLAGE OF FOWLER ORDINANCES Rhonda Feldpausch, Clerk, is instructed to contact Jim Foulds, Community Planning Services, regarding and amendment to the Village of Fowler Code of Ordinances disallowing the keeping of fowl such as chickens, ducks, etc.
