A resolution to exempt the Village from the requirements of Public Act 152 for the next<br/>succeeding year which reads as follows:</li> <li>WHEREAS Public Act 152 of 2011, passed by the legislature and signed into law by the<br/>governor, was designed to lessen the burden of employee health care costs on public<br/>employers; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, communities are given four options for complying with the requirements of Act<br/>152, depending on the impact of the Act on the employees of each community; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, the four options available to the village are: <ol> <li>apply the hard cap (capped dollar amount each government employer may pay<br/>towards an employee's health care costs;</li> <li>adopt by majority vote the 80%-20% cost-sharing model;</li> <li>ect not to follow the act;</li> <li>opt out of (exempt itself from) the cost-sharing model as set forth in the act and<br/>revisit it prior to the next plan year.</li> </ol> </li> <li>WHEREAS, the Village Council has decided to exempt itself from the requirements of the act<br/>for the next succeeding year; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, the Village Council recognizes that such exemption requires a 2/3 majority vote<br/>of the Village Council;</li> <li>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council for Village of Fowler hereby<br/>exempts itself from the requirements of Public Act 152 of 2011 for the next succeeding year;<br/>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Council for Village of Fowler hereby<br/>exempts itself from the requirements of Public Act 152 of 2011 in one<br/>year.
