The Water Fund Deficit Elimination Plan submitted to the State of Michigan was not accepted. A new plan will be drafted and the council will meet for a Special Meeting on Wednesday, August 16, 2023 to review and adopt.

Dave Pohl – Clinton County Commissioner sent correspondence outlining the following issues:

July

- The county was unsuccessful in obtaining a broadband grant.
- The 2022 audit report indicates a sound financial position.
- A request for additional funding for added record storage by the Historical Society has been approved.
- Funding to conduct internal and external cybersecurity penetration testing and an
 exercise to test the County Incident Response Plan in the event all or part of the IT
 system became unusable has been approved.
- An agreement with Blue Cross and Blue Shield for health services for inmates has been approved.
- Deputy Administrator, Todd Campbell's contract has been renewed

August

- Clinton Transit presented updated Articles of Incorporation which were adopted by the board.
- 2024 vehicle orders for the Sheriff and Drain office has been approved due to long wait time for delivery.
- Some retention and recruitment procedures have been approved as employing and keeping quality employees has become more difficult.
- Following a study of the County Prosecutors Office some recommended adjustments were made including hiring a discovery technician and an additional assistant prosecutor along with salary adjustments and some staff training.
