Dave Pohl – Clinton County Commissioner, provided an email addressing the following issues:

- 911 full conversion delayed until January 31, 2022.
- Lansing Economic Area Partnership received 185 applications received and 107 qualified for the Small Business Relief Grant Program.
- Waste Management Clean Community Event scheduled for April 30th at the

Clinton County Road Commission Facility. Free for Fall Event is September 24th at the Granger facility on Wood Street.
