An area of land in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 11, T7N, R4W, Village of Fowler, Clinton County, Michigan, the limits of said area described as: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 11; thence S01°09'48"W along the East line of said Section 11 a distance of 1081.20 feet; thence N88°50'12"W 208.00 feet; thence S01°09'48"W parallel with said East line 105.00 feet; thence N84°52'34"W 170.07 feet to the point of beginning of this description; thence N78°13'44"W 67.32 feet; thence N23°09'08"E 156.89 feet; thence Northwesterly 48.65 feet on a curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 60.00 feet, a delta angle of 46°27'28" and a chord length of 47.33 feet bearing N00°04'36"W; thence Southeasterly 357.25 feet on a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 75.00 feet, a delta angle of 272°54'56" and a chord length of 103.33 feet bearing S66°50'52"E; thence Southwesterly 48.65 feet on a curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 60.00 feet, a delta angle of 46°27'28" and a chord length of 47.33 feet bearing S46°22'52"W; thence S23°09'08"W 143.60 feet to the point of beginning; said area containing 0.67 acre, more or less; said area subject to all easements and restrictions, if any.

- 3. That said street is a public street and is for public street purposes.
