CLINTON TRANSIT MILLAGE RENEWAL RESOLUTION

The Fowler Village Council met Monday, September 12, 2016 at 7:00 PM with and President Vernon J. Thelen presiding.

The pledge of allegiance was given to the flag. Roll was called and a quorum reported. Present were: David Klein, Roy Smith, Rick Fink, John Childers, Mike Porter, John Rademacher, and Rhonda Feldpausch. Absent: Greg Halfmann. Vern Feldpausch.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Fink, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Porter, to approve the minutes of the August 8, 2016 regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Porter moved, supported by Trustee Fink, to approve payment of \$ 54,836.93 from the General Fund, \$1,055.29 from the Water O & M Fund, \$637.50 from the Major Street Fund, and \$10,447.57 from the Sanitary O & M Fund. Motion carried.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Fink moved, supported by Trustee Childers, to approve zoning permit #AB 2016-03 submitted by Jim and Marsha Koenigsknecht. Motion carried.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Porter, to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Smith moved, supported by Trustee Klein, to accept John Childers' resignation. Motion carried.

This resignation comes due to Trustee Childers moving out of the village.

BOARD ACTION: Trustee Klein moved, supported by Trustee Fink, to approve RES #2016-02 Supporting Clinton Transit millage Renewal Proposal which reads as follows:

WHEREAS, Clinton Transit is the transportation authority for Clinton County, providing safe, reliable transportation service to Clinton County residents, welcoming all riders, including those who need mobility assistance with buses that are equipped with lifts and ramps for the elderly and disabled; and

WHEREAS, Clinton Transit has operated from 2006 through 2016 with a voter approved millage of up to .2 (2 tenths) of a mill, levied throughout Clinton County, and

WHEREAS, Clinton Transit will be placing a millage renewal question

before the voters of Clinton County in November of 2016, requesting renewal of up to .2 (2tenths) of a mill for years 2017 through 2020, both inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the municipality of Village of Fowler does hereby pledge their support of the Clinton County Transit millage renewal.
