DAVE POHL – CLINTON COUNTY COMMISSIONER

Dave Pohl – Clinton County Commissioner sent correspondence outlining the following issues:

 The BoC approved 911 and public safety software and hardware updates which include Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Mobile Data Communications (MDC), Records Management System (RMS) and Jail Management System (JMS). This includes installing mobile units on first out fire and participating ambulance vehicles and Records Management System Administrator Training for personnel utilizing these systems.

- Received an update on the recycling programs that the Waste Management oversees and they will be continued forward another year. A formal agreement with the St Johns Lions club was added.
- Clinton County received the audit report for the Pension and the Retiree health care plans. The pension is at 96.7% and health care plan is at 155.0%. Both are well above the state requirement for remedial action.
- Renewed the Veterans Services agreement with Ingham County.
